NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners, County of Adams, State of Colorado, that the Agreement between Adams County and Urban Drainage and Flood Control District Regarding Design and Construction of Drainage and Flood Control Improvements for Dahlia Street Outfall (Agreement No. 18-06.08), a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, be and hereby is approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chair is authorized to execute said Agreement on behalf of Adams County.

AGREEMENT REGARDING DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF DRAINAGE AND FLOOD CONTROL IMPROVEMENTS FOR DAHLIA STREET OUTFALL ADAMS COUNTY

Agreement No. 18-06.08 Project No.107149

THIS AGREEMENT, by and between URBAN DRAINAGE AND FLOOD CONTROL DISTRICT (hereinafter called "DISTRICT") and ADAMS COUNTY (hereinafter called "COUNTY") and collectively known as "PARTIES";

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, DISTRICT, in a policy statement previously adopted, (Resolution No. 14, Series of 1970 and Resolution No. 11, Series of 1973) expressed an intent to assist public bodies which have heretofore enacted floodplain regulation measures; and

WHEREAS, PARTIES participated in a joint planning study titled "Drainage Outfall Systems Update Northern Commerce City and Irondale Area Basin D Outfall Alternatives Analysis" by ICON Engineering, Inc., dated June 8, 2017" (hereinafter called "PLAN"); and

WHEREAS, PARTIES now desire to proceed with design and construction of drainage and flood control improvements for Dahlia Street Outfall (hereinafter called "PROJECT"); and

WHEREAS, DISTRICT has adopted at a public hearing a Five-Year Capital Improvement Program (Resolution No. 60, Series of 2017) for drainage and flood control facilities in which PROJECT was included in the 2018 calendar year; and

WHEREAS, DISTRICT has heretofore adopted a Special Revenue Fund Budget for calendar year 2018 subsequent to public hearing (Resolution No. 55, Series of 2017) which includes funds for PROJECT; and

WHEREAS, DISTRICT's Board of Directors has authorized DISTRICT financial participation for PROJECT (Resolution No. 50, Series of 2018); and

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners of COUNTY and the Board of Directors of DISTRICT have authorized, by appropriation or resolution, all of PROJECT costs of the respective PARTIES.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises contained herein, PARTIES hereto agree as follows:

1. <u>SCOPE OF AGREEMENT</u>

This Agreement defines the responsibilities and financial commitments of PARTIES with respect to PROJECT.

2. <u>SCOPE OF PROJECT</u>

A. <u>Final Design</u>. PROJECT shall include the final design of improvements in accordance with the recommendations defined in PLAN. Specifically, the final design of facilities shall

extend from approximately East 74th Avenue to north of the O'Brian Canal at the Dahlia Detention Basin, as shown on Exhibit A.

B. <u>Construction</u>. PROJECT shall include construction by COUNTY of the drainage and flood control improvements as set forth in the final design including vegetation establishment.

3. <u>PUBLIC NECESSITY</u>

PARTIES agree that the work performed pursuant to this Agreement is necessary for the health, safety, comfort, convenience, and welfare of all the people of the State, and is of particular benefit to the inhabitants of PARTIES and to their property therein.

4. <u>PROJECT COSTS AND ALLOCATION OF COSTS</u>

- A. PARTIES agree that for the purposes of this Agreement PROJECT costs shall consist of and be limited to the following:
 - 1. Final design services;
 - 2. Construction of improvements;
 - 3. Contingencies mutually agreeable to PARTIES.
- B. It is understood that PROJECT costs as defined above are not to exceed \$150,000 without amendment to this Agreement.

PROJECT costs for the various elements of the effort are estimated as follows:

*It is anticipated that funds for construction shall be added to this Agreement at a future date.

This breakdown of costs is for estimating purposes only. Costs may vary between the various elements of the effort without amendment to this Agreement provided the total expenditures do not exceed the maximum contribution by all PARTIES plus accrued interest, if applicable.

C. Based on total PROJECT costs, the maximum percent and dollar contribution by each party shall be:

*Percentage share may adjust to account for additional COUNTY contribution to cover increases in the final design. DISTRICT maximum 2018 contribution will not increase.

5. MANAGEMENT OF FINANCES

As set forth in DISTRICT policy (Resolution No. 11, Series of 1973, Resolution No. 49, Series of 1977, and Resolution No. 37, Series of 2009), the funding of a local body's one-half share may come from its own revenue sources or from funds received from state, federal or other sources of funding without limitation and without prior DISTRICT approval.

Within 30 days of request for payment by COUNTY, DISTRICT shall remit to COUNTY 50% of these costs attributed to PROJECT, up to DISTRICT's full share of \$75,000. COUNTY shall provide a periodic accounting of PROJECT funds as well as a periodic notification to DISTRICT of any unpaid obligations.

6. <u>FINAL DESIGN</u>

The contracting officers for PARTIES, as defined under Paragraph 13 of this Agreement, shall select an engineer mutually agreeable to both PARTIES. COUNTY shall contract with selected engineer and shall supervise and coordinate the final design including right-of-way delineation subject to approval of the contracting officer for DISTRICT. Payment for final design shall be made by COUNTY as the work progresses from the PROJECT fund established as set forth above. Final design services shall consist of, but not be limited to, the following:

- A. Preparation of a work plan schedule identifying the timing of major elements in the design;
- B. Preparation of detailed construction plans and specifications;
- C. Preparation of an estimate of probable construction costs of the work covered by the plans and specifications;
- D. Preparation of an appropriate construction schedule.
- COUNTY shall provide any written work product by the engineer to DISTRICT.

7. OWNERSHIP OF PROPERTY AND LIMITATION OF USE

COUNTY shall own the property either in fee or non-revocable easement and shall be responsible for same. It is specifically understood that the right-of-way is being used for drainage and flood control purposes. The properties upon which PROJECT is constructed shall not be used for any purpose that shall diminish or preclude its use for drainage and flood control purposes. COUNTY may not dispose of or change the use of the properties without approval of DISTRICT. If, in the future, COUNTY disposes of any portion of or all of the properties acquired upon which PROJECT is constructed pursuant to this Agreement; changes the use of any portion or all of the properties upon which PROJECT is constructed pursuant to this Agreement; or modifies any of the improvements located on any portion of the properties upon which PROJECT is constructed pursuant to this Agreement; and COUNTY has not obtained the written approval of DISTRICT prior to such action, COUNTY shall take any and all action necessary to reverse said unauthorized activity and return the properties and improvements thereon, acquired and constructed pursuant to this Agreement, to the ownership and condition they were in immediately prior to the unauthorized activity at COUNTY's sole expense. In the event COUNTY breaches the terms and provisions of this Paragraph 7 and does not voluntarily cure as set forth above, DISTRICT shall have the right to pursue a claim against COUNTY for specific performance of this portion of the Agreement.

8. <u>MANAGEMENT OF CONSTRUCTION</u>

- A. <u>Costs</u>. Construction costs shall consist of those costs as incurred by the most qualified contractor(s) including detour costs, licenses and permits, utility relocations, and construction related engineering services as defined in Paragraph 4 of this Agreement.
- B. Construction Management and Payment
 - 1. COUNTY, with the concurrence of DISTRICT, shall administer and coordinate the construction-related work as provided herein.
 - 2. COUNTY, with concurrence of DISTRICT, shall select and award construction contract(s).
 - COUNTY shall require the contractor to provide adequate liability insurance that includes DISTRICT. The contractor shall be required to indemnify DISTRICT. Copies of the insurance coverage shall be provided to DISTRICT.
 - 4. COUNTY, with assistance of DISTRICT, shall coordinate field surveying; staking; inspection; testing; acquisition of right-of-way; and engineering as required to construct PROJECT. COUNTY, with assistance of DISTRICT, shall assure that construction is performed in accordance with the construction contract documents including approved plans and specifications and shall accurately record the quantities and costs relative thereto. Copies of all inspection reports shall be furnished to DISTRICT on a weekly basis. COUNTY shall retain an engineer to perform all or a part of these duties.
 - 5. COUNTY, with concurrence of DISTRICT, shall contract with and provide the services of the design engineer for basic engineering construction services to include addendum preparation; survey control points; explanatory sketches; revisions of contract plans; shop drawing review; as-built plans; weekly inspection of work; and final inspection.
 - 6. PARTIES shall have access to the site during construction at all times to observe the progress of work and conformance to construction contract documents including plans and specifications.
 - 7. COUNTY shall review and approve contractor billings. COUNTY shall remit payment to contractor based on billings.
 - 8. COUNTY, with concurrence of DISTRICT, shall prepare and issue all written change or work orders to the contract documents.
 - 9. PARTIES shall jointly conduct a final inspection and accept or reject the completed PROJECT in accordance with the contract documents.
 - 10. COUNTY shall provide DISTRICT a set of reproducible "as-built" plans.

C. <u>Construction Change Orders</u>. In the event that it becomes necessary and advisable to change the scope or detail of the work to be performed under the contract(s), such changes shall be rejected or approved in writing by the contracting officers. No change orders shall be approved that increase the costs beyond the funds available in the PROJECT fund, including interest earned on those funds, unless and until the additional funds needed to pay for the added costs are committed by all PARTIES.

9. <u>MAINTENANCE</u>

PARTIES agree that COUNTY shall own and be responsible for maintenance of the completed and accepted PROJECT. PARTIES further agree that DISTRICT, at COUNTY's request, shall assist COUNTY with the maintenance of all facilities constructed or modified by virtue of this Agreement to the extent possible depending on availability of DISTRICT funds. Such maintenance assistance shall be limited to drainage and flood control features of PROJECT. Maintenance assistance may include activities such as keeping flow areas free and clear of debris and silt, keeping culverts free of debris and sediment, repairing drainage and flood control structures such as drop structures and energy dissipaters, and clean-up measures after periods of heavy runoff. The specific nature of the maintenance assistance shall be set forth in a memorandum of understanding from DISTRICT to COUNTY, upon acceptance of DISTRICT's annual Maintenance Work Program.

DISTRICT shall have right-of-access to right-of-way and storm drainage improvements at all times for observation of flood control facility conditions and for maintenance when funds are available.

10. FLOODPLAIN REGULATION

COUNTY agrees to regulate and control the floodplain of Irondale Gulch within COUNTY in the manner prescribed by the National Flood Insurance Program and prescribed regulations thereto as a minimum.

PARTIES understand and agree, however, that COUNTY cannot obligate itself by contract to exercise its police powers. If COUNTY fails to regulate the floodplain of Irondale Gulch within COUNTY in the manner prescribed by the National Flood Insurance Program and prescribed regulations thereto as a minimum, DISTRICT may exercise its power to do so and COUNTY shall cooperate fully.

11. TERM OF AGREEMENT

Despite the date that this Agreement is signed by PARTIES, the term of this Agreement shall commence upon the earlier of the date of final execution by all PARTIES or December 31 of the year that it is tendered to COUNTY for execution and shall terminate three (3) years after the final payment is made to the construction contractor and the final accounting of funds on deposit at DISTRICT is provided to all PARTIES pursuant to Paragraph 5 herein, except for Paragraph 10. <u>FLOODPLAIN REGULATION</u>, Paragraph 7. <u>OWNERSHIP OF PROPERTY AND</u> <u>LIMITATION OF USE</u>, and Paragraph 9. <u>MAINTENANCE</u>, which shall run in perpetuity.

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12. <u>LIABILITY</u>

Each party hereto shall be responsible for any suits, demands, costs or actions at law resulting from its own acts or omissions and may insure against such possibilities as appropriate.

13. <u>CONTRACTING OFFICERS</u>

- A. The contracting officer for COUNTY shall be the Engineering Manager, 4430 S. Adams County Parkway, Suite 2000B, Brighton, Colorado 80601.
- B. The contracting officer for DISTRICT shall be the Executive Director, 2480 West 26th Avenue, Suite 156B, Denver, Colorado 80211.
- C. The contracting officers for PARTIES each agree to designate and assign a PROJECT representative to act on the behalf of said PARTIES in all matters related to PROJECT undertaken pursuant to this Agreement. Each representative shall coordinate all PROJECT-related issues between PARTIES, shall attend all progress meetings, and shall be responsible for providing all available PROJECT-related file information to the engineer upon request by DISTRICT or COUNTY. Said representatives shall have the authority for all approvals, authorizations, notices or concurrences required under this Agreement. However, in regard to any amendments or addenda to this Agreement, said representative shall be responsible to promptly obtain the approval of the proper authority.

14. <u>RESPONSIBILITIES OF PARTIES</u>

COUNTY shall be responsible for coordinating with DISTRICT the information developed by the various consultants hired by COUNTY and for obtaining all concurrences from DISTRICT needed to complete PROJECT in a timely manner. DISTRICT agrees to review all concept plans, preliminary design plans, and final plans and specifications; and to provide comments within 21 calendar days after the drafts have been provided by COUNTY to DISTRICT.

15. <u>AMENDMENTS</u>

This Agreement contains all of the terms agreed upon by and among PARTIES. Any amendments to this Agreement shall be in writing and executed by PARTIES hereto to be valid and binding.

16. <u>SEVERABILITY</u>

If any clause or provision herein contained shall be adjudged to be invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction or by operation of any applicable law, such invalid or unenforceable clause or provision shall not affect the validity of the Agreement as a whole and all other clauses or provisions shall be given full force and effect.

17. <u>APPLICABLE LAWS</u>

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Colorado. Jurisdiction for any and all legal actions regarding this Agreement shall be in the State of Colorado and venue for the same shall lie in the county where PROJECT is located.

18. ASSIGNABILITY

No party to this Agreement shall assign or transfer any of its rights or obligations hereunder without the prior written consent of the nonassigning party or parties to this Agreement.

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19. <u>BINDING EFFECT</u>

The provisions of this Agreement shall bind and shall inure to the benefit of PARTIES hereto and to their respective successors and permitted assigns.

20. ENFORCEABILITY

PARTIES hereto agree and acknowledge that this Agreement may be enforced in law or in equity, by decree of specific performance or damages, or such other legal or equitable relief as may be available subject to the provisions of the laws of the State of Colorado.

21. TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT

This Agreement may be terminated upon thirty (30) days' written notice by any party to this Agreement, but only if there are no contingent, outstanding contracts. If there are contingent, outstanding contracts, this Agreement may only be terminated upon the cancellation of all contingent, outstanding contracts. All costs associated with the cancellation of the contingent contracts shall be shared between PARTIES in the same ratio(s) as were their contributions.

22. <u>PUBLIC RELATIONS</u>

It shall be at COUNTY's sole discretion to initiate and to carry out any public relations program to inform the residents in PROJECT area as to the purpose of PROJECT and what impact it may have on them. Technical information shall be presented to the public by the selected engineer. In any event DISTRICT shall have no responsibility for a public relations program, but shall assist COUNTY as needed and appropriate.

23. <u>NO DISCRIMINATION IN EMPLOYMENT</u>

In connection with the performance of work under this Agreement, PARTIES agree not to refuse to hire, discharge, promote or demote, or to discriminate in matters of compensation against any person otherwise qualified because of race, color, ancestry, creed, religion, national origin, gender, age, military status, sexual orientation, marital status, or physical or mental disability and further agree to insert the foregoing provision in all subcontracts hereunder.

24. <u>APPROPRIATIONS</u>

Notwithstanding any other term, condition, or provision herein, each and every obligation of COUNTY and/or DISTRICT stated in this Agreement is subject to the requirement of a prior appropriation of funds therefore by the appropriate governing body of COUNTY and/or DISTRICT.

25. <u>NO THIRD PARTY BENEFICIARIES</u>

It is expressly understood and agreed that enforcement of the terms and conditions of this Agreement, and all rights of action relating to such enforcement, shall be strictly reserved to PARTIES, and nothing contained in this Agreement shall give or allow any such claim or right of action by any other or third person on such Agreement. It is the express intention of PARTIES that any person or party other than any one of PARTIES receiving services or benefits under this Agreement shall be deemed to be an incidental beneficiary only.

26. <u>ILLEGAL ALIENS</u>

PARTIES agree that any public contract for services executed as a result of this intergovernmental agreement shall prohibit the employment of illegal aliens in compliance with §8-17.5-101 C.R.S. *et seq.* The following language shall be included in any contract for public services:

- A. At the time of execution of this Agreement, CONTRACTOR does not knowingly employ or contract with an illegal alien who will perform work under this Agreement.
- B. CONTRACTOR shall participate in the E-Verify Program, as defined in § 8 17.5-101(3.7),
 C.R.S., to confirm the employment eligibility of all employees who are newly hired for employment to perform work under this Agreement.
- C. CONTRACTOR shall not knowingly employ or contract with an illegal alien to perform work under this Agreement.
- D. CONTRACTOR shall not enter into a contractor with a subconsultant or subcontractor that fails to certify to CONTRACTOR that it shall not knowingly employ or contact with an illegal alien to perform work under this Agreement.
- E. CONTRACTOR shall confirm the employment eligibility of all employees who are newly hired for employment to perform work under this Agreement through participation in the E-Verify Program.
- F. CONTRACTOR is prohibited from using the E-Verify Program procedures to undertake pre-employment screening of job applicants while performing its obligation under this Agreement, and that otherwise requires CONTRACTOR to comply with any and all federal requirements related to use of the E-Verify Program including, by way of example, all program requirements related to employee notification and preservation of employee rights.
- G. If CONTRACTOR obtains actual knowledge that a subconsultant or subcontracctor performing work under this Agreement knowingly employs or contract with an illegal alien, it will notify such subconsultant or subcontractor and PARTIES within three (3) days. CONTRACTOR shall also then terminate such subconsultant or subcontractor if within three (3) days after such notice the subconsultant or subcontractor does not stop employing or contracting with the illegal alien, unless during such three (3) day period the subconsultant or subcontractor provides information to establish that the subconsultant or subcontractor has not knowingly employed or contracted with an illegal alien.
- H. CONTRACTOR shall comply with any reasonable request made in the course of an investigation by the Colorado Department of Labor and Employment under authority of § 8-17.5-102(5), C.R.S.
- CONTRACTOR shall, within twenty days after hiring an employee who is newly hired for employment to perform work under this Agreement, affirms that it has examined the legal work status of such employees, retained file copies of the documents required by 8 U.S.C. Section 1324a, and not altered or falsified the identification documents for such employees. CONTRACTOR shall provide a written, notarized copy of the affirmation to PARTIES.

27. <u>GOVERNMENTAL IMMUNITIES</u>

PARTIES hereto intend that nothing herein shall be deemed or construed as a waiver by any party of any rights, limitations, or protections afforded to them under the Colorado Governmental Immunity Act (§ 24-10-101, *et seq.*, C.R.S.) as now or hereafter amended or otherwise available at law or equity.

28. INTENT OF AGREEMENT

Except as otherwise stated herein, this Agreement is intended to describe the rights and responsibilities of and between PARTIES and is not intended to and shall not be deemed to confer rights upon any person or entities not named as PARTIES, nor to limit in any way the powers and responsibilities of COUNTY, DISTRICT or any other entity not a party hereto.

29. <u>EXECUTION IN COUNTERPARTS – ELECTRONIC SIGNATURES</u>

This Agreement, and all subsequent documents requiring the signatures of PARTIES to this Agreement, may be executed in two or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which shall constitute one and the same instrument. PARTIES approve the use of electronic signatures for execution of this Agreement, and all subsequent documents requiring the signatures of PARTIES to this Agreement. Only the following two forms of electronic signatures shall be permitted to bind PARTIES to this Agreement, and all subsequent documents requiring the signatures of PARTIES to this Agreement.

A. Electronic or facsimile delivery of a fully executed copy of a signature page; or

B. The image of the signature of an authorized signer inserted onto PDF format documents.

Documents requiring notarization may also be notarized by electronic signature, as provided above. All use of electronic signatures shall be governed by the Uniform Electronic Transactions Act, CRS §§ 24-71.3-101 to -121.

WHEREFORE, PARTIES hereto have caused this instrument to be executed by properly authorized signatories as of the date and year written below.

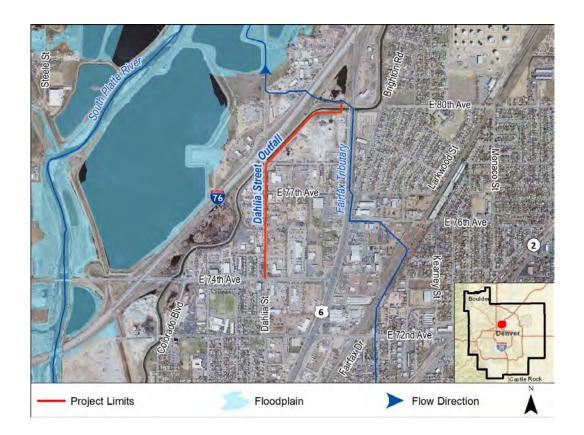

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the Board of County Commissioners approves a resolution to adopt an amendment to the Subdivision Improvements Agreement for construction of public and private improvements as part of development of Blackstone Ranch Filing 3A subdivision.

BACKGROUND:

On August 9, 2018, the BoCC approved a final plat for Filing 3-A of the subdivision and a Subdivision Improvement Agreement for both the final plat of Filing 3-A and the proposed Filing 3B of the subdivision. Since approval of the Subdivision Improvement Agreement (SIA), the developer has decided to construct the filings and associated public improvements independently of each other. On August 23, 2018, the applicant submitted a request to amend the approved SIA to reflect the requirements for constructing public improvements for each filing (See Exhibit 1).

The subject request is consistent with the requirement for approval for SIAs. In addition, staff has reviewed the proposed SIA amendment and determined the documents conform to the requirements outlined in Section 5-02-05 of the County's Development Standards and Regulations.

As a requirement of the Subdivision Improvements Agreement, the Developer has furnished the County with a performance bond, releasable only by the County, to guarantee compliance with this Agreement. Said collateral is for one million and nine-hundred twenty-eight thousand and eight-hundred twenty-six dollars (\$1,928,826).

RESOLUTION APPROVING A FIRST AMENDED AND RESTATED SUBDIVISION IMPROVEMENTS AGREEMENT FOR BLACKSTONE RANCH FILING 3

WHEREAS, it is provided by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners, County of Adams, that where designated the Developer shall have entered into a written agreement with the County to install public and/or private improvement, and to deed land for public purposes or right-of-way or submit cash-in-lieu; and,

WHEREAS, on July 31, 2018, the Board of County Commissioners, in Case No. PLT2018-00009, Blackstone Ranch, approved a Major Subdivision (Final Plat) to allow 88 lots on approximately 31.5 acres in the R-1-C, residential-1-C zone district; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners, County of Adams, State of Colorado, that the First Amended and Restated Subdivision Improvements Agreement for Blackstone Ranch Filing 3, Case No's. PLT2018-00009 and SIA2018-00007, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Board of County Commissioners is authorized to execute this AGREEMENT on behalf of the County of Adams, State of Colorado.

FIRST AMENDED AND RESTATED SUBDIVISION IMPROVEMENTS AGREEMENT

THIS FIRST AMENDED AND RESTATED SUBDIVISION IMPROVEMENTS AGREEMENT ("Agreement") is made and entered into by and between the County of Adams, State of Colorado, hereinafter called "County," and PaulsCorp, LLC, a Colorado limited liability company whose address is 270 St. Paul Street, Ste. 300, Denver, Colorado 80206, hereinafter called "Developer."

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Developer is the owner of real property in the County of Adams, State of Colorado, as described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto, and by this reference made a part hereof.

WHEREAS, it is provided by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners ("BoCC"), County of Adams, that where designated the Developer shall have entered into a written agreement with the County to install public and/or private improvements.

WHEREAS, the BoCC and the Developer entered into that certain Subdivision Improvements Agreement on July 31, 2018, which was recorded in the public records of Adams County on August 8, 2018 at Reception Number 2018000063951 (the "Original Agreement").

WHEREAS, the Developer desires to time the installation and construction of the Blackstone Ranch Filing No. 3 subdivision improvements and single-family detached dwellings in a manner that maximizes the efficiency of the development in light of the anticipated impacts of seasonal weather changes on street construction.

WHEREAS, to that end, this Agreement amends, restates, and replaces the Original Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto promise, covenant, and agree as follows:

1. Engineering Services. Developer shall furnish, at its own expense, all engineering and other services in connection with the design and construction of the improvements described and detailed on Exhibit "B" attached hereto, and by this reference made a part hereof. Pursuant to the Original Agreement, Developer has obtained the approval of the Adams County Transportation Department and Development Engineering Services for all construction plans and engineering reports prepared by the Developer in connection

with the design and construction of the improvements described and detailed on Exhibit "B".

- 3. **Drawings and Estimates**. Pursuant to the Original Agreement, Developer has furnished drawings and cost estimates for all improvements described and detailed on **Exhibit "B"** for approval by the County. The Developer shall furnish one set of "as built" drawings and a final statement of construction costs to the County.
- 4. **Construction**. Developer shall furnish and construct, at its own expense and in accordance with drawings and materials approved by the County, the improvements described and detailed on **Exhibit "B"**.
- 5. Time for Completion. Improvements shall be completed according to the terms of this agreement within "construction completion date" appearing in Exhibit "B". The County may for good cause, grant extension of time for completion of any part or all of improvements appearing on said Exhibit "B". Any extension of time shall be in written form only.
- 6. Guarantee of Compliance. Pursuant to the Original Agreement, Developer has furnished to the County a cash escrow deposit or other acceptable collateral, releasable only by the County, to guarantee compliance with this Agreement. Said collateral is in the amount of one million nine hundred twenty-eight thousand eight hundred twenty-six dollars (\$1,928,826), including twenty percent (20%) to cover administration and five percent (5%) per year for the term of the Agreement to cover inflation. Upon approval of the final plat, completion of said improvements constructed according to the terms of this agreement, and preliminary acceptance by the County, the collateral shall be released. Completion of said improvements will be determined solely by the County, and a reasonable part of said collateral, up to twenty percent (20%), may be retained to guarantee maintenance of public improvements for a period of one year from the date of completion.

The final plat is approved, and collateral has been furnished. Except as provided below, no building permits will be issued until the improvements described in **Exhibit "B"** have been preliminarily accepted by the County.

Building permits for Block 1, Lots 1 through 18, inclusive; Block 2, Lots 1 through 14, inclusive; and Block 2, Lot 28 (collectively, "Northern Lots") may be issued after approval of building plans by the County following completion and satisfactory inspection (to the same physical and documentary standards that the County uses for "preliminary acceptance") by the County of required improvements to East 26th Avenue, East 25th Avenue, Trout Road between East 25th Avenue and East 24th Place, and East 24th Place between Trout Road and Aspen Street (collectively, "Northern Streets"), as such

improvements are described in the Agreement and approved construction plans. The Northern Lots and Northern Streets are depicted on **Exhibit "C"**.

No Certificate of Occupancy for a building on any of the Northern Lots shall be granted until such time as all of the improvements described in **Exhibit "B**" have been preliminarily accepted by the County. Although the contemplated inspections of the Northern Streets shall be completed promptly after their completion, formal "preliminary acceptance" of the Northern Streets shall be concurrent with preliminary acceptance of the balance of the required public improvements described in **Exhibit "B**".

- 7. Acceptance and Maintenance of Public Improvements. All improvements designated "public" on Exhibit "B" shall be public facilities and become the property of the County or other public agencies upon acceptance of the improvements. During the period of one year from and after the acceptance of public improvements, the Developer shall, at its own expense, make all needed repairs or replacement due to defective materials or workmanship which, in the opinion of the County, become necessary. If, within ten days of written notice to the Developer from the County requesting such repairs or replacements, the Developer has not undertaken with due diligence to make the same, the County may make such repairs or replacements at the Developer's expense. In the case of an emergency such written notice may be waived.
- 8. Successors and Assigns. This Agreement shall be binding upon the heirs, executors, personal representatives, successors, and assigns of the Developer, and shall be deemed a covenant running with the real property as described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto.
- Improvements and Dedication. The undersigned Developer hereby agrees to provide the following improvements, and to dedicate described property.
 - A. Improvements. Designate separately each public and private improvement.

Public Improvements: (see Exhibit "B")

See Exhibit "B" for description, estimated quantities, and estimated construction costs.

The improvements shall be constructed in accordance with all County requirements and specifications in accordance with the approved plans and preliminarily accepted in accordance with section 5-02-05-01 of the County's Development Standards and Regulations prior to the construction completion date indicated in **Exhibit "B"**.

B. Public dedication of land for right-of-way purposes or other public purpose. Upon approval of this agreement by the BoCC, the Developer hereby agrees to convey by subdivision plat to the County of Adams the following described land for right-ofway or other public purposes: The rights-of-way shown on the Final Plat of Blackstone Ranch Filing No. 3, known as East 25th Avenue, East 24th Place, East 24th Avenue, West Road, and part of Aspen Street, more particularly described and depicted thereon.

- 10. **Termination of Original Agreement.** Upon mutual execution of this Agreement, the Original Agreement is terminated and of no further force and effect.
- 11. **Counterparts.** This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which shall be deemed to be an original and all such counterparts taken together shall be deemed to constitute one and the same instrument.

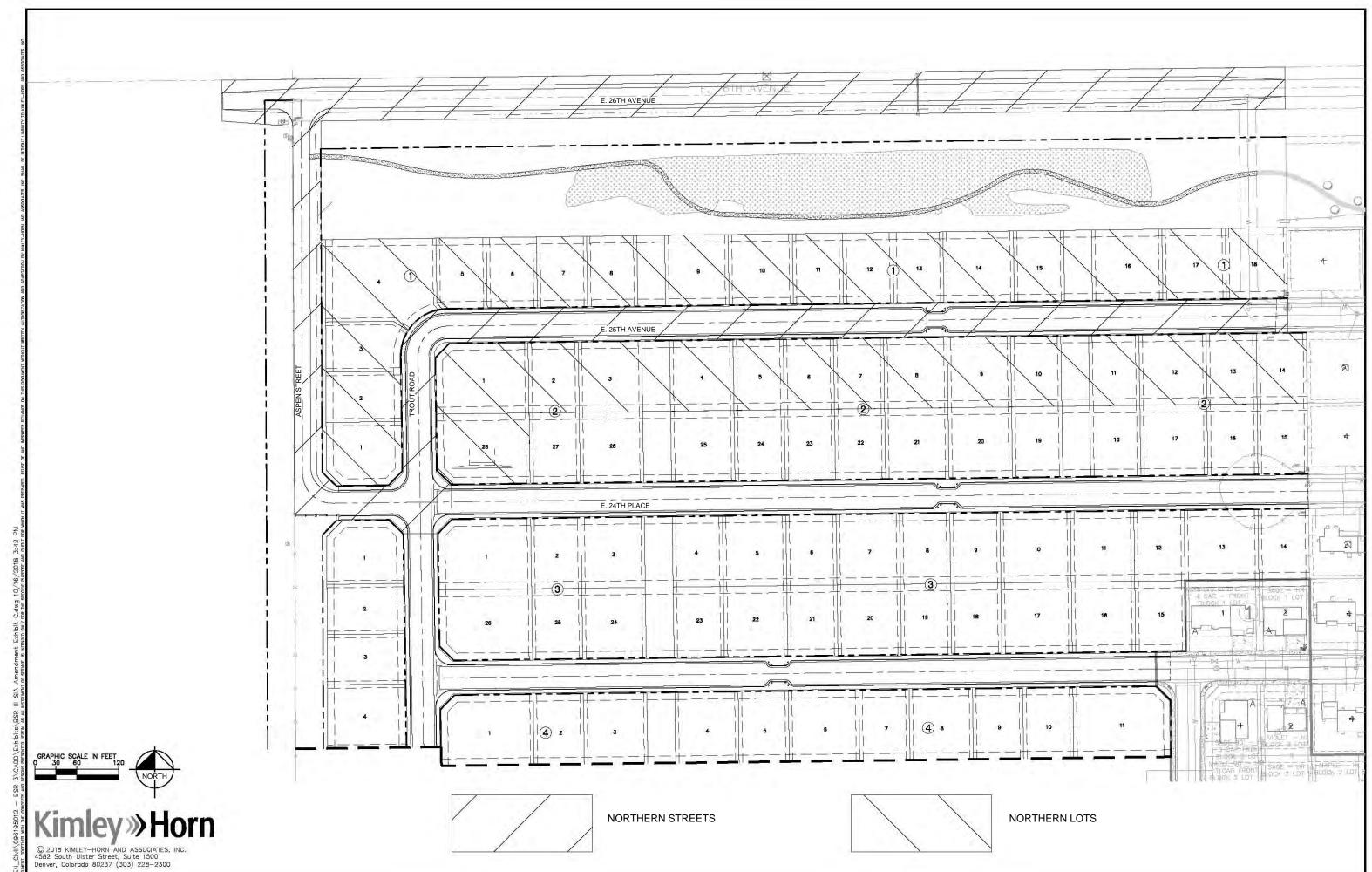
