# Proclamation "National Adoption Day" November 22, 2019

**Whereas**, Adams County recognizes the importance of giving children permanent, safe and loving families through adoption; and

**Whereas**, more than 118,000 children in the United States foster care system are waiting to be adopted; and

**Whereas**, as a result of the partnership between Adams County and the 17th Judicial District Court, Adams County anticipates finalizing 140 adoptions in 2019; and

**Whereas**, approximately 27 children in Adams County are waiting for permanent families; and

**Whereas**, to help these children find permanent, nurturing families, the local courts of Adams County will open their doors on National Adoption Day, Friday, November 22, 2019 to finalize the adoptions of local children and join other organizations to celebrate all adoptions; and

**Whereas**, this effort, along with similar celebrations in all 50 states around the country, will offer children the chance to live with stable and loving families and encourage other dedicated individuals to make a powerful difference in the lives of a child through adoption.

**How, Therefore, Be It Resolved,** that the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Adams, State of Colorado, proclaims November 22, 2019 as

#### "National Adoption Day"

and recognizes the entire month of November 2019 as National Adoption Month in Adams County, and urges all citizens to join in a national effort to raise awareness about the importance of adoption.

## **BACKGROUND:**

On July 17, 2018, the Board of County Commissioners approved the first agreement with the Mile High Flood District (MHFD) for the Clear Creek at BNSF Crossing project with stormwater funding. The project involves removing a large sheet pile drop structure in the Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railroad right-of-way and replacing the drop structure with several small, navigable drop structures that have recreational features. In addition, uplands areas around Little Dry Creek Lake will be improved and additional parking will be provided.

Design is ongoing. Funding for design and construction is transitioning from the Public Works Department to the Parks, Open Space, and Cultural Arts Department. In 2019, the Open Space Projects fund included a budget of \$2,250,000 for this project. The proposed amendment adds this funding to the project so that funding can be transferred to Mile High Flood District into the account for this project. In addition, Mile High Flood District will allocate \$125,000 in 2019 toward the project. The total project cost that has been budgeted by Adams County and MHFD to date is \$3,125,000. Additional funding will come from the Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railroad, an Open Space Sales Tax grant, and future Adams County contributions (proposed in 2020 budget).

#### WITNESSETH:

# 2. Paragraph 5. MANAGEMENT OF FINANCES is deleted and replaced as follows:

### 5. MANAGEMENT OF FINANCES

As set forth in DISTRICT policy (Resolution No. 11, Series of 1973, Resolution No. 49, Series of 1977, and Resolution No. 37, Series of 2009), the funding of a local body's share may come from its own revenue sources or from funds received from state, federal or other sources of funding without limitation and without prior Board approval.

Payment of each party's full share (COUNTY - \$3,000,000; DISTRICT - \$125,000) shall be made to DISTRICT subsequent to execution of this Agreement and within 30 days of request for payment by DISTRICT. The payments by PARTIES shall be held by DISTRICT in a special fund to pay for increments of PROJECT as authorized by PARTIES, and as defined herein. DISTRICT shall provide a periodic accounting of PROJECT funds as well as a periodic notification to COUNTY of any unpaid obligations. Any interest earned by the monies contributed by PARTIES shall be accrued to the special fund established by DISTRICT for PROJECT and such interest shall be used only for PROJECT upon approval by the contracting officers (Paragraph 13).

Within one year of completion of PROJECT if there are monies including interest earned remaining which are not committed, obligated, or disbursed, each party shall receive a share of such monies, which shares shall be computed as were the original shares; or at COUNTY

request, COUNTY share of remaining monies shall be transferred to another special fund held by DISTRICT.

3. All other terms and conditions of Agreement No. Adams County shall remain in full force and effect.

# **BACKGROUND:**

The City of Thornton owns and operates the Cooley East and West Reservoirs. The reservoirs are located within the City's jurisdiction. More particularly, the reservoirs are located one to the North and one to the South of  $104^{th}$  Avenue, both west of the South Platte River, and are adjacent to the County's Elaine T Valente Open Space. The reservoirs are used to store raw water that will be used by the City to in order to provide citizens of Thornton with potable water. Thornton's designs call for a transfer of water from Cooley East to Cooley West via a 22 inch pipeline. The Pipeline would be installed on County owned land through a portion of the parcel known as Elaine T Valente Open Space. As such, the City is seeking permissions related through the attached temporary and permanent Easements and is offering compensation in the amount of \$6,572.31.

After review with Community Economic & Development along with Parks & Open Space, staff recommends approving the easement through County owned property.

WHEREAS, Parks & Open Space has reviewed the Easements and impacts to ETV including Trails and approves the request along with Easements; and,

WHEREAS, the compensation for these Easements is \$ 6,572.31; and,

WHEREAS, City states this pipeline will support its ability to store raw water and provide potable water to its residents within Adams County;

#### WITNESSETH

- 1. That for and in consideration of the sum of Seven Hundred Forty Nine and 31/100 DOLLARS (\$749.31) other good and valuable consideration, and of the covenants and agreements contained herein, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is acknowledged, Grantor hereby grants to Grantee a Temporary Access and Construction Easement ("TCE") for ingress and egress through, to, in, on, over, across and along property owned by Grantor, as described and depicted in **Exhibit A** (Sheets 1-6) attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference the ("Property") for the purpose of construction and installation of a water pipeline including all improvements and appurtenances related thereto as described and depicted in **Exhibit B** attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference ("Improvements"). This TCE further includes the right to use the Property for construction of the Improvements and equipment and material storage during construction.
- 2. The term of this TCE shall commence thirty (30) days after Grantee gives written notice to Grantor at the address set forth above of Grantee's intent to commence construction and shall continue for a term of eighteen (18) months from the date stated in the notice of intent to commence construction. Grantor also grants to Grantee the option to extend this TCE on a month to month basis, not to exceed one (1) year from the date of expiration hereof, for the additional sum of TO BE DETERMINED (\_\_\_\_\_\_), per month upon Grantee's written notice to Grantor of exercise of the option to extend this TCE.
- 3. Grantee covenants and agrees to restore the Property, including landscaping, fences, or other improvements existing on the Property at the time this TCE commences to a condition comparable to its condition prior to construction.
- 4. During the term of this TCE, Grantor shall not itself or through other persons or entities, erect or construct any building or other structure, or drill or operate any well, or construct any permanent obstruction, or allow the installation of other utilities on, over or in the Property within said TCE, which may interfere with Grantee's full enjoyment of the rights hereunder.
- 5. The Parties hereto agree that neither has made or authorized any agreement with respect to the subject matter of this instrument other than expressly set forth herein, and no oral representation, promise, or consideration different from the terms herein contained shall be binding on either Party, its agents or employees.

- 6. The covenants herein contained shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the Parties hereto, their respective heirs, personal representatives, successors and assignees.
- 7. The signatories hereto warrant that they have full and lawful authority to make the grant, covenants and promises herein above contained as Grantor, and the covenants and promises herein above made as Grantee.

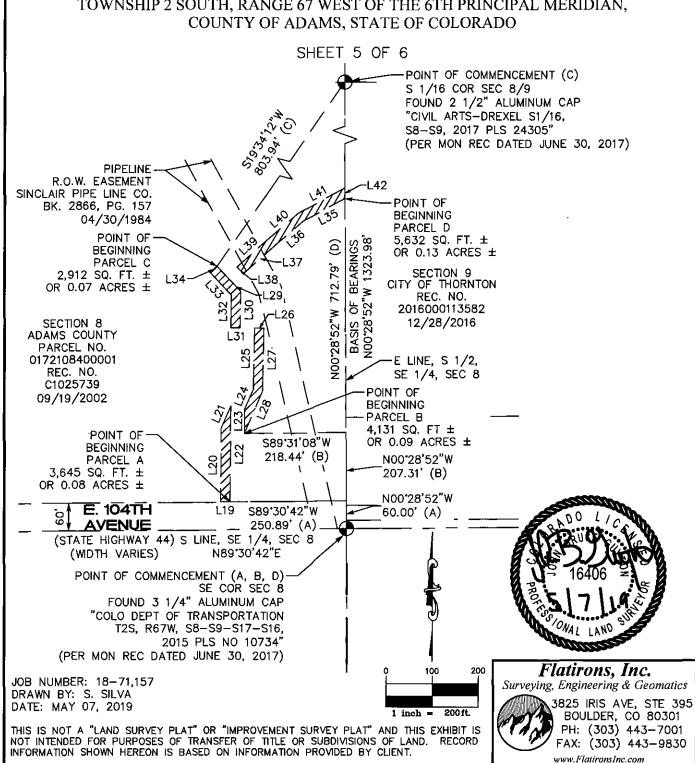

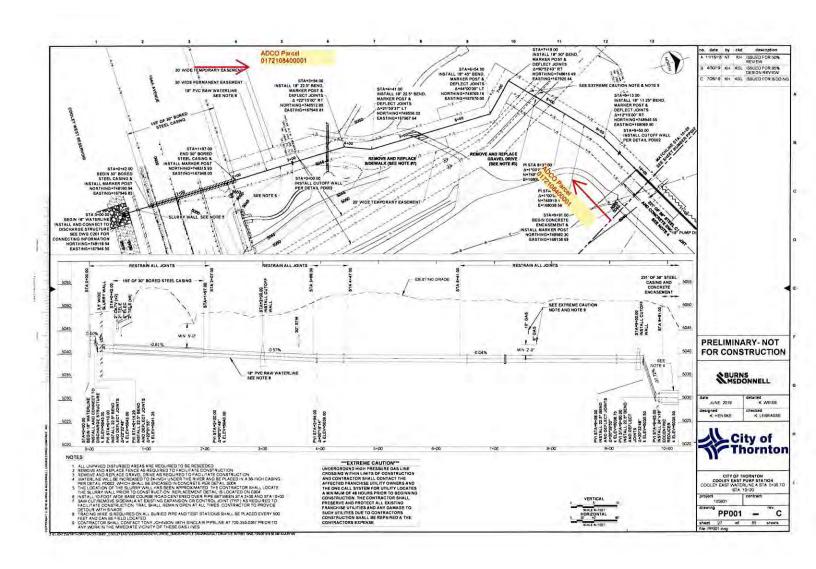

The Parties hereto agree that neither has made or authorized any agreement with respect to the subject matter of this instrument other than expressly set forth herein, and no oral representation, promise, or consideration different from the terms herein contained shall be binding on either party, or its agents or employees, hereto.
- 7. All of the covenants herein contained shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the Parties hereto, their respective heirs, personal representatives, successors and assigns.

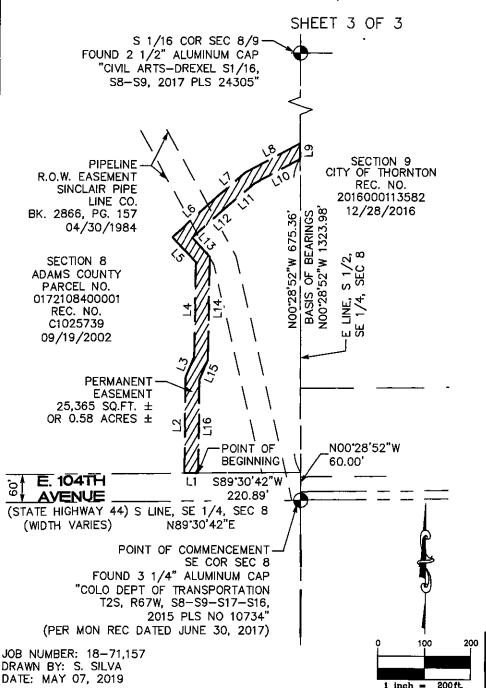

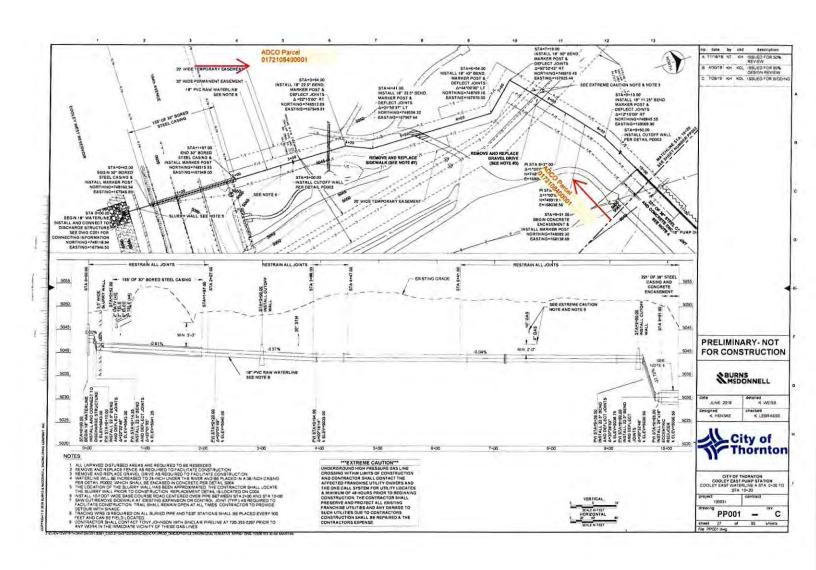


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## Exhibit B Pipelines in ADCO Property

Adams County will fund half of the position in that period and the remaining eight municipalities will fund the other half based on population.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Colo. Const. art. XIV, § 18, and § 29-1-203, C.R.S., as amended, the Parties are authorized to cooperate and contract with one another to provide any function, service, or facility lawfully authorized to each; and,

WHEREAS, Adams County and the Cities of Arvada, Brighton, Commerce City, Federal Heights, Northglenn, Thornton, Westminster, and the Town of Bennett (collectively, the "Parties") intend to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement ("IGA") to address the cost associated with a Census Liaison position ("Position") with Adams County; and,

WHEREAS, the Parties intend to fund the Position for two years from April 2019 through April 2021; and,

WHEREAS, the total two-year cost of the Position is estimated to be one hundred twenty-four thousand dollars (\$124,000); and,

WHEREAS, the Parties intend that the proportionate contributions set forth in the Scope of Work be committed to pay the cost of the Position; and,

WHEREAS, in the event the Position cost is less than the estimated cost, the Parties agree that the excess funds will be refunded to the Parties based upon the proportionate share of their contributions; and,

WHEREAS, in the event the Position cost is more than the estimated cost, the Parties agree that no additional contributions will be requested by the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners, County of Adams, State of Colorado, that the Intergovernmental Agreement Between Adams County and the Cities of Arvada, Brighton, Commerce City, Federal Heights, Northglenn, Thornton, Westminster, and the Town of Bennett for sharing the cost of a Census Liaison position in Adams County is hereby approved.

This Intergovernmental Agreement ("IGA") is made on this \_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_\_, 2019, by and between Adams County Board of County Commissioners, located at 4430 South Adams County Parkway, Suite C5000A, Brighton, Colorado 80601, hereinafter referred to as "County" and the City of Arvada, Colorado, located at 8101 Ralston Road, Arvada, Colorado 80002; the City of Brighton, Colorado, located at 500 South 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Brighton, Colorado 80601; the City of Commerce City, Colorado, located at 7887 East 60<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Commerce City, Colorado 80022; the City of Federal Heights, Colorado, located at 2380 West 90<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Federal Heights, Colorado, 80260; the City of Northglenn, Colorado, located at 11701 Community Center Drive, Northglenn, Colorado 80233; the City of Thornton, Colorado, located at 9500 Civic Center Drive, Thornton, Colorado 80229; the City of Westminster, Colorado, located at 4800 West 92<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, Westminster, Colorado 80031; and the Town of Bennett, located at 207 Muegge Way, Bennett, Colorado 80102; collectively referred to herein as "Municipalities". The County and Municipalities may be collectively referred to herein as the "Parties".

WHEREAS, pursuant to Colo. Const. art. XIV, § 18, and § 29-1-203, C.R.S., as amended, the Parties are authorized to cooperate and contract with one another to provide any function, service, or facility lawfully authorized to each; and,

WHEREAS, the Parties intend to enter this IGA to address the cost associated with a Census Liaison position ("Position") with Adams County; and,

WHEREAS, the Parties intend to fund the Position for two years from April 2019 through April 2021; and,

WHEREAS, the total two-year cost of the Position is estimated to be one hundred twenty-four thousand dollars (\$124,000); and,

WHEREAS, the Parties intend that the proportionate contributions set forth in the Scope of Work be committed to pay the cost of the Position; and,

WHEREAS, in the event the Position cost is less than the estimated cost, the Parties agree that the excess funds will be refunded to the Parties based upon the proportionate share of their contributions; and,

WHEREAS, in the event the Position cost is more than the estimated cost, the Parties agree that no additional contributions will be requested by the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements contained herein, the parties hereby agree as follows:

#### **SECTION 1- SCOPE OF THE IGA**

The Parties will perform their obligations under this IGA according to the Scope of Work, attached hereto and fully incorporated herein as Attachment A.

#### **SECTION II- TERM OF THE IGA**

The Term of this IGA shall be for the two-year period ending on April 30, 2021.

#### **SECTION III- ALLOCATION OF COSTS**

The Municipalities agree to pay funds in accordance with the attached Scope of Work directly to Adams County no later than March 1, 2020.

#### SECTION IV- ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS

Nothing herein shall constitute a multiple fiscal year obligation of any Party pursuant to Article X, Section 20, of the Colorado Constitution (TABOR). Each Party's financial obligations under this Agreement are contingent upon its legislative body's annual appropriation of funds to discharge the obligations set forth in this Agreement.

#### **SECTION V - INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR**

In providing services under this IGA, the County acts as an independent contractor and not as an employee of the Municipalities. The County shall be solely and entirely responsible for its acts, and the acts of its employees, agents, servants, and subcontractors during the term and performance of this IGA. No employee, agent, servant, or subcontractor of the County shall be deemed to be an employee, agent, or servant of the Municipalities because of the performance of any services or work under this IGA. The County, at its sole expense, shall procure and maintain workers' compensation insurance and unemployment compensation insurance as required under Colorado law. Pursuant to the Workers' Compensation Act, § 8-40-202(2)(b)(IV), C.R.S., as amended, the County understands that it and its employees and servants are not entitled to workers' compensation benefits from the Municipalities. The County further understands that it is solely obligated for the payment of federal and state income tax on any moneys earned pursuant to this IGA.

#### **SECTION VI - NONDISCRIMINATION**

The Parties shall not discriminate against any employee or qualified applicant for employment because of age, race, color, religion, marital status, disability, sex, or national origin. The Parties agree to post in conspicuous places, available to employees and applicants for employment, notices provided by the local public agency setting forth the provisions of this nondiscrimination clause.

#### **SECTION VII- HOLD HARMLESS**

Each Party assumes responsibility for the actions and/or omissions of its agents and its

employees in the performance or failure to perform under this Agreement, and further, each Party, to the extent authorized by law, agrees to hold harmless the other for such actions or omissions of its own employees and/or agents. It is agreed that such liability for actions and omissions of agents and employees is not intended to increase the amounts set forth in the Colorado Governmental Immunity Act, now existing, or as may be amended. By agreeing to this provision, no Party waives nor intends to waive, as to any person not a party to this Agreement the limitations on liability which are provided to each party under the Colorado Governmental Immunity Act § 24-10-101, C.R.S.

#### SECTION VIII - INSURANCE AND GOVERNMENTAL IMMUNITY

During the term of this IGA, the County agrees to maintain insurance in all forms and types as required by law through either commercial policies or self-insurance. Nothing in this IGA shall be construed as a waiver by any party of any provisions of the Colorado Governmental Immunity Act, § 24-10-101, et seq., C.R.S., as amended.

#### **SECTION IX - TERMINATION**

Any Party may terminate its participation in this IGA upon the provision of written notice to the other Parties at least 30 days prior to the effective date of the termination. No funds will be returned to any Party due to termination of this agreement.

#### **SECTION X - MUTUAL UNDERSTANDINGS**

#### A. Jurisdiction and Venue

The laws of the State of Colorado shall govern as to the interpretation, validity, and effect of this IGA. The Parties agree that jurisdiction and venue for any disputes arising under this IGA shall be with the 17<sup>th</sup> Judicial District, Colorado.

#### B. Compliance with Laws

During the performance of this IGA, the Parties agree to strictly adhere to all applicable federal, state, and local laws, rules and regulations, including all licensing and permit requirements. The Parties hereto aver that they are familiar with § 18-8-301, et seq., C.R.S. (Bribery and Corrupt Influences), as amended, and § 18-8-401, et seq., C.R.S. (Abuse of Public Office), as amended, and that no violations of such provisions are present. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing and as applicable, the Parties expressly agree to comply with the privacy and security requirements of the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPAA) when exposed to or provided with any data or records under this IGA that are considered to be "Protected Health Information."

#### C. Record Retention

The County shall maintain records and documentation of the services provided under this IGA, including fiscal records, and shall retain the records for a period of three (3) years from the date this IGA is terminated, unless otherwise provided or required by law. Said

records and documents shall be subject at all reasonable times to inspection, review, or audit by authorized federal, state, or County personnel.

#### D. <u>Assignability</u>

Neither this IGA, nor any rights hereunder, in whole or in part, shall be assignable or otherwise transferable by any party without the prior written consent of the Parties.

#### E. Waiver

Waiver of strict performance or the breach of any provision of this IGA shall not be deemed a waiver, nor shall it prejudice the waiving party's right to require strict performance of the same provision, or any other provision in the future, unless such waiver has rendered future performance commercially impossible.

#### F. Notice

Any notices given under this IGA are deemed to have been received and to be effective: (1) three (3) days after the same shall have been mailed by certified mail, return receipt requested; (2) immediately upon hand delivery; or (3) immediately upon receipt of confirmation that a facsimile was received. #### **SCOPE OF WORK**

#### **CENSUS LIAISON POSITION**

Adams County has hired a Census Liaison, which is a project-designated position from April 2019 through April 2022. This individual will serve as a primary contact and coordinator for Adams County's efforts related to the 2020 Census, which includes the implementation and coordination of activities, branding, messaging, and stakeholder engagement, to ensure the best and most complete count in Adams County. In addition to leading Adams County's Complete Count Committee, the Census Liaison will work with municipal and organizational partners to:

- Develop a plan for a coordinated regional approach
- Coordinate efforts with the U.S. Census bureau
- Develop strategies on reaching hard-to-count neighborhoods and populations
- Create and deliver presentations to City Councils, staff, stakeholder groups, and partner agencies
- Coordinate with other departments, offices, and agencies to respond to data inquiries related to the 2020 Census

#### MUNICIPAL ENGAGEMENT

Adams County recognizes that while cities understand the value of the Census, resources can be limited due to other priorities, which is why Adams County desires to lead the Complete Count Committee Census efforts. The areas in which the Census Liaison and Adams County agrees to support the Municipalities include, but is not limited to:

- Identifying and targeting hard-to-count communities
- Work closely with U.S. Census Bureau throughout and utilizing their tools and resources
- Creation, development, and purchasing of materials that promote the 2020 Census
- Attend already-established community events throughout Adams County that are hosted by municipalities, nonprofit organizations, faith-based groups, business partners, among others
- Work with nonprofit organizations that are trusted partners by the hard-to-count communities
- Help organizations identify and apply for grants related to 2020 Census efforts
- Sponsor and attend public forums and events to provide information to community members through direct outreach
- Have multiple in-person discussions with people in hard-to-count populations
- Partner and provide more intensive outreach that could include discussions for households with limited English, outreach to homeless populations, and work with people who do not have access to the internet or are not familiar with filling out computer forms

- Utilize the County's GIS manager to assist with canvassing efforts and other partner needs
- Utilize the funding received through any grants to the Adams County Complete Count Committee to the benefit of all the Parties

#### The Municipalities agree to:

- Pass a proclamation in support of the 2020 Census and the Adams County Complete Count Committee
- Be involved and engage with our Complete Count Committee or subcommittee as the Municipalities see fit
- Notify the Census Liaison of community events that city staff are aware of
- Help identify nonprofit organizations and other potential partners that could help support Census efforts
- Provide a portion of the funding for a two-year period for the Census Liaison position

#### **BACKGROUND:**

The homelessness liaison applied for the ESG Street Outreach funding opportunity through DOLA on October 18, 2019. The grant proposal described the need for street outreach in Adams County, specifically outreach to vulnerable populations experiencing literal homelessness and to those who are unwilling or unable to access emergency shelter, housing, or an appropriate health facility. Three main components in the grant proposal include: a) utilizing a homelessness street outreach coordinator, b) expanding of basic needs services such as food, transportation, clothes, housing navigation, VI-SPDAT assessments, etc., and c) creating the Adams County Street Outreach Network. The Network will be a collaboration between community partners, police departments, first responders, code enforcement departments, parks and open space departments, etc. to create a proactive response for connecting people living in encampments and vehicles/RVs to services and housing solutions. While the outreach staff will be housed in the Department of Community Safety and Well-Being, we anticipate the coordinator to work closely with the Sheriff's Office, Parks and Open Space, and Human Services.

Except as specifically modified by this Amendment, all terms used in this Amendment that are defined in the Contract shall be construed and interpreted in accordance with the Contract.

#### 3. AMENDMENT EFFECTIVE DATE AND TERM

#### A. Amendment Effective Date

This Amendment shall not be valid or enforceable until the Amendment Effective Date shown on the Signature and Cover Page for this Amendment and upon full execution of substantially the same amendment with all counties listed in this Contract. The State shall not be bound by any provision of this Amendment before that Amendment Effective Date, and shall have no obligation to pay Contractor for any Work performed or expense incurred under this Amendment either before or after of the Amendment term shown in §3.B of this Amendment.

#### B. Amendment Term

The Parties' respective performances under this Amendment and the changes to the Contract contained herein shall commence on the Amendment Effective Date shown on the Signature and Cover Page for this Amendment or upon full execution of substantially the same amendment with all counties listed in this Contract, whichever is later and shall terminate on the termination of the Contract.

#### 4. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Amendment is to:

- A. Grant CDHS permission to extend and amend its agreement with TALX corporation;
- B. Formally add participating counties to the "annual minimum" table; and
- C. Update pricing.

#### 5. MODIFICATIONS

The Contract and all prior amendments thereto, if any, are modified as follows:

A. Exhibit A is hereby replaced with Exhibit A-2, which is attached and incorporated into this Amendment.

#### 6. LIMITS OF EFFECT AND ORDER OF PRECEDENCE

This Amendment is incorporated by reference into the Contract, and the Contract and all prior amendments or other modifications to the Contract, if any, remain in full force and effect except as specifically modified in this Amendment. Except for the Special Provisions contained in the Contract, in the event of any conflict, inconsistency, variance, or contradiction between the provisions of this Amendment and any of the provisions of the Contract or any prior modification to the Contract, the provisions of this Amendment shall in all respects supersede, govern, and control. The provisions of this Amendment shall only supersede, govern, and control over the Special Provisions contained in the Contract to the extent that this Amendment specifically modifies those Special Provisions.

#### Exhibit A-2 – Statement of Work

#### A. Background

For purposes of this Exhibit A, Contractor may also be referred to as "County." The State has entered into a contract ("Universal Membership Agreement")(State contract routing number 16 IHEA 83111)(Exhibit B) with TALX Corporation, a provider of Equifax Verification Services ("EVS") and intends to execute an amendment ("Schedule A")(State contract routing number 16 IHEA 87603)(Exhibit C) to the Universal Membership Agreement (collectively "Work Number Agreement"). The Work Number Agreement allows EVS to provide employment verification services directly to Colorado counties. The State acts only as a pass-through entity, meaning that EVS will bill the State for fees incurred by the counties, and the State will then bill the counties individually.

The Work Number Agreement is between the State and EVS with participating counties each signing Participation Agreements (see Exhibit 1 to Universal Membership Agreement). The Work Number Agreement obligates the counties collectively and Contractor individually to pay EVS via the State for services rendered so the State and County are entering into this Contract to memorialize the State's and County's responsibilities as they relate to the Work Number Agreement.

#### B. Payment

County shall pay the State for County's use of services within the scope of the Work Number Agreement. The State shall promptly pass through County's payments to EVS in accordance with the Work Number Agreement. Except within its role as a pass through entity, the State is not liable for County's obligations incurred under this Contract or the Work Number Agreement. The State shall provide each County an invoice at least 30 days prior to the date the payment is due to EVS. The State shall ensure that any payment to the State is paid over to EVS prior to the date that payment is due to EVS.

#### C. Annual Minimum

The Work Number Agreement by the terms of the Schedule A obligates each Participating County, through the State as the pass-through entity, to pay the Participating County's proportionate share of the Annual Minimum Payment as set forth in this Intergovernmental Agreement and Exhibit 1 to the Schedule A. The Annual Minimum Payment is \$2,100,000.00, which is based upon an estimated 375,000 income verification requests at \$5.60 per income verification request, plus a \$2,000 per month service fee. County's responsibility for its share of any deficiency survives termination of this Contract or the Work Number Agreement.

County is responsible for its percentage of the Annual Minimum Payment based upon the following formula:

[County's Minimum Usage] / [Total Participating counties' Previous Usage] = County Percentage [County Percentage] X [Annual Minimum Payment] + [Admin Fee] = County Financial Obligation

IF County's Actual Annual Payment is less than County's Financial Obligation, THEN County is considered a Deficient County and shall pay any deficiency according to the following formula:

[Annual Minimum Payment] – [Total Actual Annual Payment] = Total Deficiency

[County Financial Obligation] – [County Actual Annual Payment] = County Deficiency

[County Deficiency] / [Total counties' Deficiency] = Deficient County Percentage

[Deficient County Percentage] X [Total Deficiency] = Deficient County Payment to State

#### **D.** Miscellaneous Provisions

- 1. State is acting as a fiscal agent for County, passing through payment of all costs from County to EVS, including the Annual Minimum Payment. The State shall not be liable for any debt or payment obligation, including the Annual Minimum Payment, incurred by County pursuant to this Contract or the Work Number Agreement, provided, however, that any failure by the State to pass through such payments from County shall constitute a breach of this Contract by the State. The State shall be obligated to pay over to EVS any funds received from a County. Upon breach of this agreement by the State, the County shall have the right to terminate this Contract upon written notice and at least thirty (30) days in which the State may cure the breach or any other remedy allowed by law. If County fails to pay the State for County's costs incurred under this Contract or the Work Number Agreement, the State shall have the right to terminate this Contract upon written notice and at least thirty (30) days in which County may cure the breach.
- 2. The Work Number Agreement is for the benefit of County. Any amendments or changes to the Work Number Agreement or any new Schedule A or amendments to Schedule A must be signed by or approved by a person authorized by the governing body for each County in accordance with the County's local procedures prior to the amendment or change being effective as to a participating county. The State shall not execute amendments or revisions to the Work Number Agreement or Schedule A that bind any participating county without the participating counties' consent as provided herein.
- 3. County's liability for any unpaid fees owed under this Contract or the Work Number Agreement shall survive termination of this Contract as to County who has not paid all required fees until the State receives payment from County.
- 4. Annual Termination: Unless specified elsewhere in this Contract or the Work Number Agreement, the State or County may only terminate this Contract, upon 60 days written notice, so as to align with the end of an annual term stated in the Work Number Agreement. If a County elects to terminate it shall not be obligated to expend any funds, including any annual minimum payment, for the years following its termination.
- 5. The State may execute similar agreements with new counties not originally part of this Contract or the Work Number Agreement. If the State executes a similar agreement with a new county or counties, the State and County will recalculate the annual minimum for the subsequent annual term.
- 6. County hereby grants the State authority to do the following:
  - a. Extend until October 31, 2020 the State's agreement with TALX corporation; and
  - b. Amend, in accordance with this Amendment, the State's agreement with TALX Corporation.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

Due to the rapid growth of the County over the past several years, a space utilization study has been conducted for the Government Center to improve security, client access, workflow and efficiency. A plan has been developed to achieve these goals with the need for tenant finish construction services.

A formal Request for Proposal was posted on BidNet to provide CMGC services for Space Utilization at the Adams County Government Center. Proposals were opened on August 30, 2019. At the time of solicitation, the projected cost for Phase I was \$450,000. The following seven (7) firms provided proposals:

- 1. Adolfson and Peterson Construction
- 2. Alliance Construction Solutions, LLC
- 3. Taylor Kohrs, LLC
- 4. Saunders Construction, LLC
- 5. Whitestone Construction
- 6. Growling Bear Company
- 7. MW Golden Constructors

After the RFP was issued and proposals were received and evaluated, the scope for Phase I Space Utilization project changed, increasing the project in excess of \$1 million dollars. Purchasing Policy No. 1071 stipulates that pre-qualification is required of contractors for projects in excess of \$1 million dollars prior to participating in the Request for Proposal (RFP) process, and the results of such be presented to the BOCC for review and comment. The BOCC was informed of this issue in AIR on October 8, 2019 and gave direction to proceed with the existing pre-qualified contractor list pursuant to the Exceptions allowed in Policy 1071. The pre-qualified contractors will then be invited to participate in the formal RFP process.

Upon notification of the proposed increased scope of Phase I, Staff pre-approved proposing firms to ensure the County is in compliance with Purchasing Policy No. 1071. All the top-listed respondents below have been approved in other Statement of Qualifications projects within the last year:

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- 1. Adolfson and Peterson Construction Fleet and Public Works Building
- 2. Alliance Construction Solutions, LLC South Platte Crossing Renovation
- 3. Taylor Kohrs, LLC Leader Blade Station and Strasburg Wash Bay Project
- 4. Saunders Construction, LLC South Platte Crossing Renovation
- 5. MW Golden Constructors Leader Blade Station and Strasburg Wash Bay Project

The Evaluation Committee decided to interview the top two scoring firms, Taylor Kohrs, LLC and Saunders Construction, LLC. After completion of the interviews, it was determined that Saunders Construction, LLC provided the best overall value to the County.

It is recommended that Saunders Construction, LLC be awarded for pre-construction services for Phase I Space Utilization at the Adams County Government Center. The initial stage of this project is for the pre-construction/design in the amount of \$2,122.00 with the Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) to be finalized prior to soliciting construction services for this project.
