REQUEST FOR DD214

Generally, the Colorado Open Records Act permits access to a variety of information. However, such access is denied when it would be contrary to any State or Federal statute or regulation. (CRS 24-72-204)

While Colorado permits members of the military who have separated from service to file their DD214 at no cost with the Clerk and Recorder, Federal law (5 USC 552(B)(6)) restricts access to such personnel, medical and similar files.

The National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) formulated certain requirements for the dissemination of military records such as the DD214. This office has adopted those requirements.

Copies of DD214's are available to veterans and next of kin of deceased veterans. Next of kin are the un-remarried widow or widower, son or daughter, father or mother, brother or sister of the deceased veteran. Authorized third party requestors (lawyers, doctors, historians, etc.) may submit requests for copies of a DD214 from individual records with an authorization dated and signed by the veteran or the veteran's next of kin.
