You should apply for your child if you are income eligible (please see the chart below) or if they are foster children, homeless, a runaway, a migrant or if they receive:

- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits
- Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations (FDPIR)
- Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF)
